

RE: Homework

Below is an outline of Hedgehog Class' homework expectations.

Reading

Reading books will need to be brought back into school daily and will be changed every other day or when the book is completed.

The children will also bring home a free reading book of their choice to share with a member of the family.

We would like children to read daily at home, with an adult and independently if they are fluent. It is important for your child to understand what they have read. Please ask your child the questions at the back of the phonic books and encourage discussion throughout the story to ensure they have an understanding of what is happening and meanings of new vocabulary.

Mental Arithmetic

Mental arithmetic is a very important aspect of mathematics, so we urge parents and carers to encourage your child to practise their number bonds (within 20) regularly so they can recall them at speed. Children will be given a random number bond test on Thursdays which look similar to the following questions:

The children will receive a short task on Friday afternoon that will enable the children to practise the skills that have been taught at school. **Homework should be handed in on Wednesday**.

Speaking and Listening Project

During this half term, I would like the children to prepare a short presentation on the countries, continents and oceans of our world. They may want to research a country or continent, make a map, use a compass, name the five oceans or they may have an idea of their own. The children can present their project however they wish, e.g. PowerPoint, poster, drawing, photographs but they need to be prepared to share their findings with the class by Friday 15th October 2021.
