

This week we have been looking at the different ways that numbers can be made. Can you recall all the number bonds to 5 and 10 really quickly? You



could make a poster or a game to share with the class.

Try some of these ...

Play a game where you choose one and your child has to find the matching number as quickly as they cand. Then swap, encourage your child to choose one and you have to find the matching number.

One person thinks of a number (or chooses a card) and the other asks questions until they can guess what it is. So here, you might ask: Is it an odd number? Is it bigger than ten? Does it go with 3 to make 20? Does it go with 5 to make 20?

- Play the games again in a couple of days time (and then a few more times, leaving increasingly long gaps between games to help her to remember them).
- Can your child identify the number bond randomly?
