Covid News

We have had achievement assemblies today for the first time in such a long time.

We will be continuing to make sure we have an enhanced cleaning routine in place in school and school will be well ventilated at all times. Staff will not generally be wearing masks any more and you will not be required to wear a mask when you visit school.

We still have a couple of positive cases of Covid but hopefully the numbers will continue to drop.

If your child has symptoms of Covid, please test them and, if the test is positive, please keep them at home for 5 days. This remains the advice from the government.
