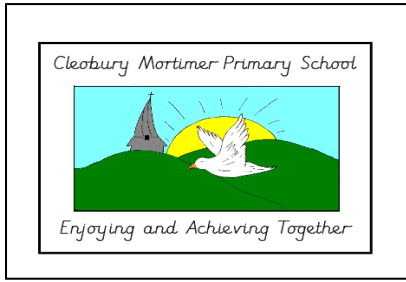

This will start once the children are settled after the Autumn half term and will be online based using webpages called, Purple Mash and My Maths. Children will be provided with login details before the half term.
