## Curriculum

### Subject Intent

As Writers we will continue to develop our use of a range of punctuation including: embedded clauses and semi colons. We will be learning to punctuate a variety of sentence structures. We will do this through writing as the different characters in Cogheart.

As Readers we will read and appreciate Cogheart.

As Mathematicians we will develop our understanding of written methods for multiplication and division. Next we will move onto fractions. We will also develop our understanding of geometry through position and direction.

As Scientists we will study Classification.

As Historians we will find out about changes within living memory and our local area. We will compare census returns and identify continuities and changes in households.

As Geographers we will locate some of the World's well know rivers and learn about the features of rivers.

As Artists/design technologists we will improve our sketching with a focus on Kyffin Williams. We will also be creating simple meals.

As Musicians we will use Fingal's Cave to explore dynamics, pitch and tempo. We will also learn to perform a range of Christmas carols.

In PE we will focus on attacking and defending activities in hockey and football.

In RE we will focus on why some people believe in God and some people not.

In French we will be learning about meeting and introducing a French family. This unit draws on vocabulary and grammar learned in previous years; introduces family and relations vocabulary, the possessive adjective, my, and how to express likes and dislikes.
