Curriculum

Subject Intent

As Writers we will learn to write different sentences to make a short story. We will learn to use expanded noun phrases to add more detail to our writing. We will also learn to use a range of different sentence types. We will be using the short story of 'Elf Road' as stimuli.

As Readers we will read be enjoying Ravi's Roar by Tom Percival to develop our vocabulary, inference and prediction skills.

As Mathematicians we will develop our understanding of addition and subtraction by bridging 10. Next, we will move onto adding three digits and explore the order of the addends.

As Scientists we will study living things.

As Geographers we will be introducing children to the basic concept of climate zones and mapping out hot and cold places globally. Looking at features in the North and South Poles and Kenya. Comparing weather and features in the local area. Learning the four compass points. Learning the names and locating the continents of our world.

As Artists/design technologists we will explore pattern, texture and tone: creating printed patterns using everyday objects, taking rubbings using different media and creating 3D drawings.

As Musicians we will use instruments to represent animals, copying rhythms, learning a traditional Ghanaian call and response song and recognising simple notation, progressing to creating call and response rhythms.

<u>In PE we will use the topic of Explorers</u> to help us choreograph a simple routine. We will also explore dodging and learn how to dodge effectively.

In RE we will be exploring Islam and finding out Who is a Muslim and how do they

In PSHE we will be Setting ground rules for RSE and PSHE lessons. We will also be learning that Learning that families are composed of different people who offer each other care and support. Learning how other people show their feelings and how to respond to them. Looking at conventions of manners and developing an understanding of self-respect.
