

Harvest Festival

On Tuesday of last week, we welcomed Reverend Buck into school to hold a Harvest Festival. As part of this celebration, we asked parents and carers to donate dried and tinned goods for the food bank. Members of staff from the foodbank came to school on Friday morning and the school councilors handed over the items we had collected over the week. This was very gratefully received and it was wonderful to strengthen our link with this important community service. Eastnor Pottery Workshop

On Wednesday and Thursday all pupils got to take part in a pottery workshop with 'Jon the Potter' from Eastnor Pottery. These tiles will then be combined into one large mural which will replicate our school logo (as used in the top right of The Flyer). Our completed mural will be ready to collect in six to eight weeks time after it has been fired. The mural will be mounted outside of school, at the entrance to the main reception. We can't wait to see the finished design!
