Curriculum

Subject Intent

As Writers we will continue to learn how to write non-chronological reports. The children will continue to develop their handwriting and spelling. They will also continue to develop their proof reading and editing skills to ensure that their writing makes sense.

As Readers we will explore The Giraffe, The Pelly and Me by Roald Dahl and develop our inference, recall and prediction skills.

As Mathematicians we will be adding and subtracting two digit numbers from/to 2 digit numbers. We will also be developing our mental calculation skills and explore multiplication and division.

As Scientists we will be exploring the properties of different materials.

As geographers we will be exploring what makes our world wonderful. Children will learn to identify and locate characteristics of the UK on a map. Identify human and physical features. Locate human and physical features on a world map. Explain the difference between oceans and seas. Name and locate the five oceans on a world map. Use an aerial photograph to draw a simple sketch map. Collect data by sketching findings on a map and completing a tally chart. Present their findings in a bar chart.

As Artists/design technologists we will be using Superheroes to help us explore sculpture and mixed media.

As Musicians we will be exploring 'musical me'. Children learn to sing and play using tuned percussion. They will also use letter notation to write a melody.

In PE we will learn how to link different movements and apparatus together in gymnastics. They will apply their knowledge and understanding of dribbling, passing and receiving in order to keep possession as a team and score a point.

In RE we will be exploring what makes some places sacred to believers.

<u>In PSHE we will be</u> learning about health and well-being. We will understand that we can feel more than one emotion at a time and explore how we can be healthy.
