Curriculum

Subject Intent

As Writers we will be looking at characterisation. The children will continue to develop their handwriting and spelling. They will also continue to develop their proof reading and editing skills to ensure that their writing makes sense. As Readers we will explore The Barnabus Project by the Fan Brothers and develop our inference, recall and prediction skills.

As Mathematicians we will be exploring equal groups, repeated addition before moving onto multiplication and division.

As Scientists we will be exploring plants.

As historians we will be developing knowledge of events beyond living memory and reinforcing their chronological understanding by looking at significant events in the history of flight on a timeline. We will also learn about the individuals who contributed to the history of flight.

As Artists/design technologists we will be exploring mechanisms by making a fairground wheel

As Musicians we will be exploring 'Space'. Children will develop their knowledge and understanding of dynamics, timbre, tempo and instruments. They will also learn to compose and play motifs.

<u>In PE we will be</u> exploring different movement combinations as we create a dance. In games, we will learn how to throw correctly. The children will apply their knowledge and understanding of throwing under and overarm to win a game.

In RE we will be exploring why does Easter matter to Christians.

In PSHE we will be developing our understanding of safety: roads, medicines and an introduction to online safety; distinguishing secrets from surprises; naming body parts and looking at the concept of privacy.
