## Curriculum

### Subject Intent

As Writers we will be learning how to persuade. The children will continue to develop their handwriting and spelling. They will also continue to develop their proof reading and editing skills to ensure that their writing makes sense.

As Readers we will explore Malala's Magic Pencil by Malala Yousafzai and develop our inference, recall and prediction skills.

As Mathematicians we will continue to explore multiplication and will move onto learn about division. The children will also learn about fractions.

As Scientists we will be exploring habitats.

As geographers we will be finding out what it is like to live by the coast. We will be naming and locating continents and oceans of the world while revisiting countries and cities of the UK and surrounding seas. Children learn about the physical features of the Jurassic Coast and how humans have interacted with this, including land use and tourism.

As Artists/design technologists we will be developing our art and design skills. We will develop our design, drawing, craft, painting and art appreciation: replicating the recognisable crockery of Clarice Cliff, exploring tone through shading, developing weaving skills, working with clay and experimenting with brush strokes.

As Musicians we will be exploring 'British songs and sounds'. Children will be creating sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.

In PE we will be developing our jumping skills. Children will develop jumping using different combinations, jumping for distance. We will also be developing of games skills and the children will develop their understanding of how they can use their hitting (striking) skills to send the ball to space in order to win a game.

In RE we will be exploring Islam.

In PSHE we will be developing our understanding of citizenship.

In Computing we will be learning how to code.
