## Curriculum

### Subject Intent

As Writers we will continue to learn the skills that we need to write a newspaper report. We will also be writing a play script and revising persuasive writing. The children will continue to develop their handwriting and spelling. They will also continue to develop their proof reading and editing skills to ensure that their writing makes sense.

As Readers we will be studying Romeo and Juliet. To understand the text better, we will be answering questions using VIPERS.

As Mathematicians we continue to develop our understanding of multiplication and division. We will be partitioning the factors to help us calculate mentally. on our mental skills to help us calculate efficiently and fluently. We will also look at manipulating and counting in hundredths and thousandths. The children will also practise their addition and subtraction within the context of money. Finally, we will build on these skills by solving problems in a range of contexts.

As Scientists we will study sound and vibration.

As Historians we will be looking at invasion and settlements.

As Designers we will be exploring mechanical systems and making a slingshot car

As Musicians we will be learning to listen to changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics and relate it to something tangible and familiar.

In PE we will use the theme of Space to explore movement and improvisation. We will also be practising our attacking and defending skills in hockey.

In RE we will be exploring Why Christians call the day Jesus dies 'Good Friday'?

In PSHE we will continue to explore health and wellbeing. We will be building awareness of online safety and the benefits and risks of sharing information online; identifying the difference between private and public; age restrictions; exploring the physical and emotional changes in puberty; the risks associated with tobacco; knowing how to help someone with asthma

In Computing we will be continuing to look at spreadsheets and write for different audiences.

In French we will be learning vocabulary all about the weather.
