• Inappropriate Language

- We are increasingly having to deal with incidents of inappropriate language being used by the children in school. I have spoken to all of the Key Stage 2 children this week and made it very clear that any incidents of appropriate language being used will be dealt with by issuing a warning and red card on the first occasion, and if such language is used again, it may result in exclusion.
- I am sure you will agree that it is completely unacceptable for this sort of language to be used. Children are telling us that they are learning these words in films, tv programmes, song lyrics, Youtube and social media. Please be aware of what your child may be accessing.

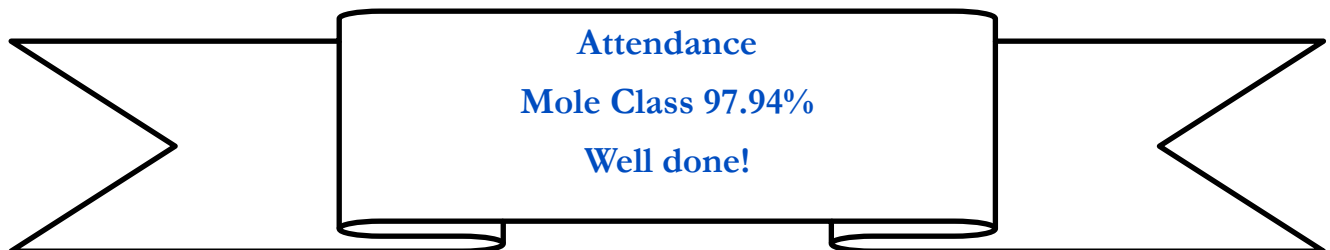
