## COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

- Personal hygiene is the most important way we can stop the spread of infection. Children wash their hands regularly in school using soap and water.

## Welcome Back

Thank you all for your co-operation, patience and understanding as we all get to grips with a new way of being together. It is quite a challenge!

In the morning, please do not arrive before 8.30 unless your child is booked into Breakfast Club. Key Stage 2 children use the car park gates. Only Key Stage 1 parents need to queue for the smaller gate.

At the end of the day, please move around onto the playgrounds and do not obstruct the gate. In that way, we will avoid large queues outside the building.

Please do not use the Lacon car park at the moment. Unfortunately, because of changes that have had to be made because of COVID, our parents and staff are no longer able to use the car park.

Please name all items of clothing and water bottles. You will not be able to come in to look for lost property at the moment and we have no capacity to store it. If an item is named, it can be returned.

The situation is changing from day to day and I will try to keep you up to date with changes we are having to make. All of our procedures and policies reflect the advice we are receiving on an almost daily basis from the government and PHE.

Although we will not routinely be using masks in school, I would recommend that parents and carers wear them when they come to collect children at the end of the day. Staff who have close contact with parents and carers will be wearing masks from next week.
