We are holding an Open Morning tomorrow for families whose children will be joining us in September 2021.

Uniform

I would like to clarify that hoodies are not part of our school uniform. When the weather was much colder, the children were allowed to wear royal blue hoodies in addition to their school uniform. The same rule still applies, but children cannot wear them instead of a cardigan, sweatshirt or jumper. Please save your child the embarrassment of being told to remove non-uniform items by making sure they come to school wearing the correct uniform. Thank you to all of the parents and carers who make sure their children come to school every day looking smart and wearing the correct uniform.

The school is growing!

In September we have our largest ever Reception intake. To accommodate the new Reception class and also the ever growing number of children in other year groups, we are adding another classroom to the school. This will be a demountable and will be positioned next to the current demountable classroom on the KS2 playground. We will be adjusting timings for breaks to deal with the decrease in size of outdoor space.

We are also adding additional space to Nursery, developing a new staffroom to accommodate an ever increasing staff, and developing a Special Education Hub in the old kitchen. It is a very exciting time for the school and I look forward to being able to invite you all in during Autumn term so that you can see all of the new developments. It is wonderful to be able to improve the learning environment for all of the children.

Information about school organization for September will come out to you in July. We are still awaiting confirmation of admissions decisions, so will not be in a position to confirm class allocations until we know exactly how many children will be in school in September.

Parking

Please do not park on the pavement outside school. It causes an obstruction and can be very intimidating for pedestrians to have cars mounting the curbs. Why not walk to school if you live within a reasonable distance? Not only is it beneficial from a health perspective, it is also good for the environment and gives you the chance to talk to the children.
