Thank you for all of your support to help us to reduce the risk of infection in our school. We have had two further cases of Covid in the past ten days, but I think it is really helping that so many parents are PCR testing their children when they are identified as close contacts. Not all of our cases have had symptoms, so it is only through testing that we can find out who is positive and stop transmission.

Thank you also to those families who are keeping children at home when there is a positive case in the household. This is really helping as well.

I know that we are sending quite a few children home at the moment if they are coughing or are unwell during the day. Thank you for supporting this precautionary measure.

Flu Vaccination

Edenred Vouchers

The government has extended its free school meal voucher scheme for October half-term, Christmas and February half-term. I have placed the order for vouchers which will be delivered on Monday 25th October. If your child receives benefit –related free school meals and you have made a successful application, you will receive a £15 per child voucher.

If your child is a new starter, you will not automatically receive free school meals vouchers, even if your older children are already in receipt of them. Unless you have made an application, you will not be eligible for vouchers for the younger child.

We are unable to host the Christmas Fair in school this year and I am grateful to Friends for planning activities which do not rely on the school as the venue for events. It would be awful to have to cancel things at the last minute because of Covid restrictions.

Christmas

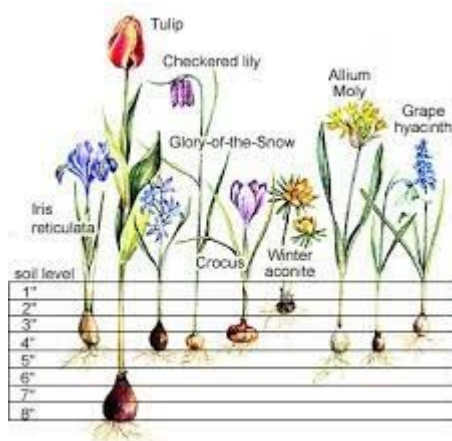
