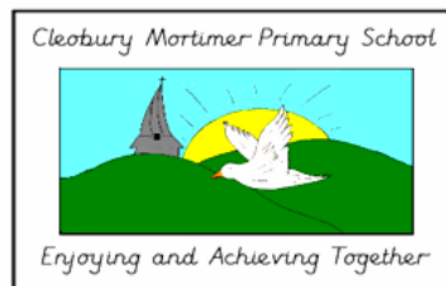

### In School this week:

Time has certainly flown in school since the start of term and it is hard to believe that we are already at the end of September. It has been wonderful to see how well the children have settled into their new classes and there is a happy, purposeful buzz in school.

This week the children in KS1 and KS2 (Years 1—6) have taken part in 'Harvest Live'. The online event was arranged by the National Farmers Union and is believed to have been the world's largest Harvest Festival! The children were able to explore the fascinating journey that our food takes to reach our plates and meet some of the people that help during the production process. The pupils in Duckling and Fox class have also spent time thinking about Harvest, as part of their 'People that help us' topic.

In addition to this, Year 6 have continued their weekly 'Police Cadet' sessions, led by our local PCSOs: Shelley Hyde and Jacqui Fletcher. This week, the focus was on 'Road Safety'. Along the theme of road safety, I was visited by two members of the town council. They came to discuss the issues with parking at school pick up and drop off times and we began to consider solutions. I appreciate parking is difficult and space is limited outside of school, but I would urge you to park considerately and always be mindful of the children's safety. In order to ease congestion, please walk if possible.

The council members also came to deliver copies of posters that have been produced to remind the public to pick up after their dogs. Last year, the children all entered a competition to design a poster and Rosie and Frankie's designs were selected as the winners. Look out for their posters around the local area!
