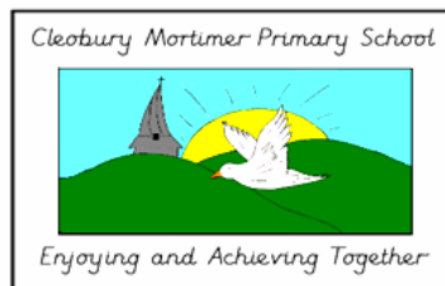

POLITE REMINDERS FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE

Unfortunately, we have confirmed cases of Covid in school, as well as increasing numbers of children who are absent with a high temperature and a cough. 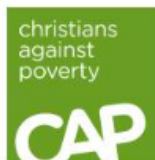
