Welcome back! I hope you all enjoyed a relaxing half term and that the children have returned re-energized and ready for what is always a busy few weeks as we begin to prepare for the lead up to Christmas.

It has been a lovely start to the half term as we have been able to welcome lots of parents into school this week. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the staff who are going with them for giving up their own time to make sure that the children have a wonderful time. The children will be trying a number of adventurous activities, such as abseiling, canoeing, rock climbing, archery and caving.
