In School this week:

I hope that this Friday Flyer finds you well and that you and your children have had a good start to the summer term. This time of year is always incredibly busy in school, and the next few weeks will be no exception. As I am sure you are aware, the next two Mondays are Bank Holidays, with an extra date being added for the King's Coronation.

King's Coronation:

In school next Friday (5th May) we will be celebrating the coronation of King Charles III. The children can come to school in non-school uniform which should follow a 'red, white and blue' theme. We will be having a 'street party' style lunch (weather permitting) and the catering team at Lacon will be providing party food as the lunch option on this day. If you would prefer to send your child with their own packed lunch, please bear in mind our party theme. More details of what the party lunch comprises of will be sent out via ParentMail next week. In the afternoon, the children will be taking part in an art competition, with a coronation theme.

Parking and Safety:

Having been on duty outside of school in the mornings and after school, I am aware of the difficulties with parking and dropping off children that parents / carers face. Unfortunately, I am also aware that there have been two 'near misses' in recent weeks, where an accident has been narrowly avoided. In order to try to minimize this risk, I would ask all families who live close enough, to walk to school where possible. I would also ask that drivers take extreme care when picking up / dropping off near to the school gates and are aware of the pedestrians. I have also requested that the local PCSOs increase their patrols in this area at the start and end of the day, in order to ensure that vehicles are parked sensibly and safely.

Safer Schools:

As part of our drive to ensure that we have a practical and realistic approach to managing risks to safety at school, we are currently working with the Safer Schools Partnership, in order to gain the Safer School Accreditation. As part of this process, we would appreciate your views and are asking if parents / carers could complete the survey that will be shared via Microsoft forms next week.

Wraparound Care:

Thank you to everyone who replied to the Forms Survey I sent out to gauge how much interest there would be in after school child care. We had a high number of responses from parents / carers who were interested in this facility, therefore I will begin the process of setting this up. My aim is that wraparound childcare will be available from September 2023. More details will follow in due course.
