SATs

Last week, our Year 6 children sat their Standardised Assessment Tests (SATs). These tests, alongside teacher assessment of English writing and science, are used to measure school performance and to make sure individual pupils have the support that they need as they move into secondary school. The papers are sent off to be externally marked and we will receive the results in July. We were SO proud of all of our Y6 pupils last week—they were cool, calm and collected and did their very best.

SATs are only one measure of a child's ability and only reflect a tiny part of who they are and what they can achieve. At Cleobury Mortimer Primary School, it is our aim to strive for academic excellence but to also ensure that we prepare pupils for 'life in all it's fullness' and this means that we are equally passionate about developing each child's character and core values and ensuring all children have a chance to shine.

Coronation Celebrations

Before the Bank Holiday weekend, we celebrated the King's Coronation in school. The pupils took part in lots of themed activities and it was wonderful to see everyone in their 'Red, White and Blue' to celebrate the event. On the Friday afternoon, after we had enjoyed our party lunch, all classes took part in an art competition with a coronation theme. Younger children designed their own crown using collage materials, Rabbit and Hare Class filled in an outline of Prince Charles with images linked to the Coronation and Year 5 and 6 completed some incredible art work where they created a 'mirror' portrait of King Charles. 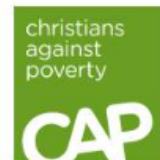
