Important Information: Holidays

Schools work with an EWO (Education Welfare Officer). One of the roles of the EWO is to monitor attendance and they can take action where attendance falls below an acceptable level and has been recorded as unauthorised. From September, there will be an increased national focus on deterring families from taking holidays in term time. Currently, I am unable to authorise family holidays and these are recorded as 'unauthorised' absences. Next academic year, not only will the absence be unauthorised, but the EWO will also issue a fine to families who take their child out of school for a family holiday. The fine is currently £60 per child, per parent. Please be aware this means a family with two children and two parents will be issued with a £240 fine. I felt it was important that families were aware of this change in advance.

During the last week of term, part of the playground next to our nursery class is going to be transformed into a fantastic EYFS outside learning area. To keep the cost of the project within budget, we are going to clear the existing area ourselves before the work begins.
