#### **New EYFS Playground**

#### **RE and Arts Week**

#### **End of Year Reports and Attendance Information**

On Friday, your child should have brought home their 'End of Year Report'. If your child is in a year group with statutory assessments, these results will have been shared with you as part of the reporting process. Included in your child's report will also be a summary of their attendance for the year. The national expectation is that a child's attendance should be at least 96%. This is because comprehensive research shows that there is a direct link between good attendance and a child's attainment. If you have any questions or comments after you have read your child's report, you are very welcome to make an appointment to speak to the class teacher. This can be arranged via the office.

#### **Ofsted**

As you know, on Tuesday 20th and Wednesday 21st June, we welcomed a team of Ofsted inspectors into school. I hope that I will receive the final report in the next few days and will therefore be able to share it with you before the summer holidays. However, we have been informed that if the report isn't ready before the summer break, Ofsted will not publish it until September.

## **Important Information: Holidays**

Schools work with an EWO (Education Welfare Officer). One of the roles of the EWO is to monitor attendance and they can take action where attendance falls below an acceptable level and has been recorded as unauthorised. From September, there will be an increased national focus on deterring families from taking holidays in term time. Currently, I am unable to authorise family holidays and these are recorded as 'unauthorised' absences. Next academic year, not only will the absence be unauthorised, but the EWO will also issue a fine to families who take their child out of school for a family holiday. The fine is currently £60 per child, per parent. Please be aware this means a family with two children and two parents will be issued with a £240 fine. I felt it was important that families were aware of this change in advance.
