Subject Intent

As Writers we will learn the skills that they need to write a newspaper report and a story. The children will continue to develop their handwriting and spelling. They will also continue to develop their proof reading and editing skills to ensure that their writing makes sense.

<u>As Readers we will</u> be studying The Phoenix of Persia by Sally Pomme Clayton and Amin Hassanzadeh Sharif. To understand the text better, we will be answering questions using VIPERS.

As Mathematicians we will develop our understanding of multiplication and will be partitioning the factors to help us calculate mentally. on our mental skills to help us calculate efficiently and fluently.
