## In School:

I would like to start this edition of The Flyer with an update about the Book Fair that we recently held at school. I am very pleased to report that the sale generated £500 for school that we able to spend on books for the children to enjoy. The event was a real success and I know that Mrs Bates has another date planned later this year.

### School Field

As you will be aware, we have started a six week consultation period to gauge local opinion about our proposal to fence the school field. On the back of The Flyer, I have included two QR codes, one that will link to the full proposal document, should you wish to read it, and one to the 'Forms' document where we are recording feedback. Currently, we are not able to make good use of the field, as it is used by dog walkers and members of the public during school hours. We are hoping to work with the local community to find a solution that gives the 241 pupils at Cleobury Mortimer Primary School safe access to outside space during the school day. It is our intention to still enable access for use by community groups outside of the school day, via a free 'booking' process. I would urge as many parents, carers and community members to contribute to the online feedback form over the six week period, to ensure that all voices and opinions are heard and can be considered.

### School Disco

Last week, we hosted the first school disco of the year—this one had a Halloween theme! Children in Fox, Duckling and Owl classes participated during the afternoon and pupils in the rest of the school returned afterschool. The FRIENDS made a fantastic £500 for our school and the children had a brilliant time. Once again, I would like to thank both Mark Davies (our site assistant and resident DJ!) and the FRIENDS for putting this very popular event on for the children and raising funds for our school.
