Curriculum

Subject Intent

As Writers we will learn about the key features of a short story based on the model text 'staying out'. The children will then learn how to use some of the key features to write a story opening.

As Readers we will be exploring and appreciating the story 'The Tale of Peter Rabbit'. We will be using our VIPERS skills to infer and deduce information from the text.

As Mathematicians we will be revisiting our number skills to 20. We will also be looking at how to add three addends together successfully, using patterns and number bonds.

As Scientists we will be learning living things. As part of this we will be looking at what living things need to survive, as well as what plants and animals have in common.

As Geographers we will be learning about different hot and cold climates. We will also be identifying continents, countries, oceans and seas on a world map.

As Artists/design technologists we will be developing our art and design skills, which includes the manipulation of clay and learning how to use a paintbrush effectively. We are also looking at how art can tell a story.

As Musicians we will be learning about orchestral instruments and how to create a repeating beat. The theme for our music unit is Africa.

In PE we will be focusing on dance, which includes putting together a sequence with music based on the theme 'explorers'. We are also completing a dodging unit, where we are learning how to use our feet and bodies to dodge.

In RE we will focus on what the good news is that Christians say Jesus brings.

In RSE we are learning about families and building relationships.
