## Curriculum

### Subject Intent

As Writers we will explore and use adjectives in our own writing.

As Readers we will read and appreciate stories such as The Really Disgusting Sandwich and The Snail and the Whale.

As Mathematicians we will explore place value and number bonds with numbers 0-20.

As Scientists we will observe, measure and record the growth of plants.

As Geographers we will locate Shanghai and compare the physical and human features to those in the UK.

As Artists we will explore sculpture and 3D art using paper.

As Musicians we will focus on pitch. We will use instruments and our voices to explore different pitches through a superhero theme.

In PE we will participate in games consisting of rackets and balls. During these games we will use team building and co-ordination skills.
