Curriculum

Subject Intent

As Writers we will use The Man Who Walked Between the Towers to inspire our writing. We will develop our skills in writing to entertain and persuade, while continuing to improve our spelling, handwriting, proofreading and editing.

As Readers we will study The Man Who Walked Between the Towers, developing our skills in retrieval, inference and vocabulary and using evidence from the text to explain our ideas.

As Mathematicians we will develop our understanding of numbers up to 1,000,000, including place value, comparing, ordering and rounding. We will also explore negative numbers and their use in real-life contexts.

As Scientists we will investigate materials, mixtures and separation, exploring how materials can be mixed and separated according to their properties. We will develop our skills in planning investigations and drawing conclusions.

As Geographers we will explore what life is like in the Alps, locating the region and investigating its physical and human features and how people live and work there.

As Artists we will explore depth, emotion and movement, developing our use of line, tone and composition to communicate ideas through drawing.

As Musicians we will develop our vocal skills through singing in harmony, learning to sing accurately and confidently while listening carefully to others.

In PE we will develop our skills in tag rugby and football, focusing on movement, teamwork and applying our skills within games.

In RE we will explore the Christian belief that God is holy and loving and consider how these beliefs influence Christian worship and everyday life.

In PSHE we will explore how we can support our minds and bodies as we grow, considering healthy choices and ways to look after our wellbeing.

In Computing we will explore databases, learning how information can be organised, searched and used to answer questions. We will also continue to develop our understanding of online safety.

In French we will explore French Monster Pets, learn vocabulary and build simple sentences to describe unusual creatures.
